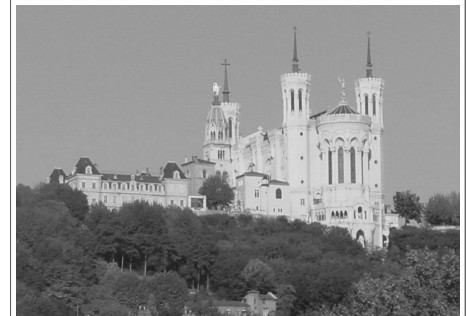

Students are housed with host families who are specially chosen for their interest in sharing French life and culture with the students. Students eat breakfast and dinner with their families during the week and all meals on weekends. Students not only communicate in French with native speakers for a significant portion of their day, they also eat French food, live in a French home, etc. It is an invaluable aspect of the program.

Undergraduate Courses

2-Week Intensive UMKC Course

The first two weeks are an intensive program specifically designed by UMKC and the Centre International d'Etudes Françaises (CIEF) with both language and cultural components.



4-Week CIEF Courses

A. Beginning and Intermediate :

Language classes: grammar, conversation, composition, phonetics, culture.

B. Advanced

1. Grammar and stylistics
2. Electives: (some possible courses)
 - a. Culture and civilization
 - b. Literature
 - c. Film

Fr 354: Lyon, Crossroads of France This course, for all students, continues throughout the 6 weeks. Taught by the UMKC faculty member the course is intended as an in depth introduction to aspects of France and French civilization through the history and culture of the city of Lyon. The course includes numerous trips to cultural and historic sites around Lyon.
