SMG WORLDWIDE, The Stock Market Game™ HOT TIPS

Collected here are a few helpful tips for successfully navigating and using SMG WORLDWIDE, The Stock Market Game™. If you have additional questions about the SMG WORLDWIDE site, please feel free to contact Vincent Young at (212) 618-0596.

Hot Tip 1: Make sure you have the correct version Web browser.

You may experience difficulties running the various functions of the SMG WORLDWIDE site on older browsers. It is recommended that you upgrade to the latest version of Internet Explorer or Netscape Communicator 4.75. DO NOT upgrade to Netscape Communicator 6.0. The Netscape 6.0 browser is incompatible with the SMG WORLDWIDE site.

Hot Tip 2: Passwords are case sensitive.

To access your trading portfolio, please go to the SMG WORLDWIDE homepage (www.smgww.org) and click on the "Enter the SMG" button at the top of the page. Upon doing so, you will be taken to the SMG WORLDWIDE login page. Please enter your Login ID and password in the designated fields. Please note that IDs and passwords are case sensitive and must be entered exactly as they were assigned.

Hot Tip 3: SMG WORLDWIDE has a built in logoff function.

To reduce the risk of having others access your portfolio the SMG WORLDWIDE portfolio site automatically logs you off after 15 minutes of inactivity. If you have not sent or received information for 15 minutes or longer you will be automatically logged off and required to return to the SMG WORLDWIDE login page to re-enter your Login ID and password.

Hot Tip 4: Help Menus are available in the portfolio pages.

From each portfolio page, you can go to on-line help screens by clicking on the HELP icon (a question mark). There are help screens for: Change Password, Investor Research, Enter a Trade, Account Summary, Account Holdings, Pending Transaction, Transaction Notes, Transaction History, Gains and Losses, and Rankings

Hot Tip 5: Trades entered after 4:00pm EST.

The market is open for trading Monday through Friday from 9:30am to 4:00pm EST. Trades made after the close of market are given the next business day's opening price.

Hot Tip 6: Validate Ticker at the Enter a Trade page.

When you wish to enter a trade and are unsure if you have the company's correct ticker symbol, type the ticker symbol into the appropriate field and click on the Validate Ticker link to the left. This will bring up a pop-up window with the name of the company and its stock's price.

Hot Tip 7: Transaction Notes is a good place to start.

Transaction Notes provides descriptions of each trade that was entered. These descriptions include errors that may have occurred causing a trade not to be processed. If your Account Holdings profile seems inaccurate, Transaction Notes is the first place to look when determining what has occurred.
