## **Field Day Training and New Student Orientation!**

**Day:** Thursday, August 6th, 2009

**Location:** Pierson Auditorium, The University Center 5000 Holmes (accessible from 50th Street & Rockhill Rd)

**Time:** 8am-12pm field training (all students, including new students) 1pm-4pm new student orientation (new students only)

### **Who Attends What?**

- All students enrolled in field practicum for fall 2009 are required to attend field training from 8am-12N
- Students and field instructors are welcome to take optional free CEU seminars in the afternoon session from 1pm-4:15pm (however, new students cannot attend due to new student orientation time conflict)
- All new students who have NOT attended a previous orientation will be required to attend new student orientation for 1pm-4pm

### **Parking Instructions**

- Parking permits will be provided to all field instructors, preceptors and presenters who attend. A Field Day volunteer will be available to give it to them upon arrival (7:30am-8:00am). Signs will prompt you to your parking location on field day.

### **Lunch Procedure: 12N-1pm**

- A complimentary lunch will be provided for all field instructors, preceptors and presenters following the morning Field training. Students may attend the student organization picnic at that time (location will be announced at Field Day) or feel free to pack your own lunch, if you plan to attend the afternoon free CEU workshops.
