How to Write an Abstract



Abstract submissions should include the following information:

- * Your Name and Contact information (email, phone)
 - * Your Academic Unit and Department
 - * Student Status (i.e., undergraduate or graduate)
 - * Your Research Mentor's Name, Email, and Department
 - * Additional Author Names (if applicable)
 - * Project Title
 - * Statement on Research Protection (If IRB approval is necessary in your field of study, please state the date on which your study was given approval)
 - * Brief (no more than 500 word) synopsis of your scholarly project (i.e., introduction/background, research question(s), methods, findings, and conclusions)
- ** Note: Submit abstracts as Word or PDF files only, please
