Second Cognate Field-Foreign Language

Proficiency equivalent to successful completion of three college semesters in one foreign language.

At UMKC, this means completing the equivalent of a foreign language 211 class (e.g. FRENCH 211, GERMAN 211)

Minimum GPA & Total Credit Hours

2.5 GPA required for graduation. 45 minimum credit hours plus a foreign language.
