Students who enter with a masters degree or prior Psychology graduate coursework may request to waive up to two courses (6 credit hours) that can be counted towards their degree. Further, students who completed an empirical thesis project as part of a masters degree elsewhere can request to waive the thesis requirement. These waivers are considered on a case-by case basis by the faculty, who will determine if a course/thesis is comparable to the requirements of the program. Student who waive thesis requirements are required to complete a comparable research project in the first two years (the "second year project"). Please note that waiving courses and/or thesis generally does not impact a student's time to degree completion.
