Note: Current graduate tuition rate is \$384.90/credit hour (in state). First year graduate students enroll in 13 credit hours in the Fall semester and 10 credit hours in the Spring semester. Thus, total (in state) costs for year 1 are \$10,136.37, which includes Fall semester tuition (\$5003.70) & fees (\$701.93) and Spring semester tuition (\$3849.00) & fees (\$581.74). Tuition costs are listed in the above table to reflect partial tuition remission received by students. Currently, first year students receive a 9 month/20 hour per week assistantship that includes a non-resident fee waiver and tuition remission for 9 credit hours per semester, and a stipend of approximately \$10,000.
